Purpose of the role

To help support the co-ordination and running of a range of nature and wildlife based adult learning events at Windsor Great Park.

These events range from wildlife walks and nature-based art to mindful photography and forest bathing.

Type of work in which you will be involved

- Opening the site at evenings and weekends to enable access for course facilitators and attendees
- Helping to prepare for the event: this might involve setting up a warm drinks station, preparing information and signage etc.
- Welcoming visitors attending the events, answering questions, making them a warm drink and guiding them to the event site
- Help the session run smoothly by staying with the group for the duration of the session and supporting the facilitator with any issues that may arise
- Providing first aid if necessary (First Aid training can be provided)
- Supporting the Learning Support Officer in marketing and promoting the Lifelong Learning events programme
- Becoming familiar with and then following BBOWT's Health and Safety Policy at all times
- Giving any other appropriate assistance as may be reasonably requested
