Chilswell Valley is a small limestone valley of about 6 hectares just outside the Oxford ring road at South Hinksey, OX1 5AP

Purpose of the role

The work party carries out a wide range of practical tasks to maintain and enhance the habitats of Chilswell Valley, comprising areas of limestone grassland, ancient woodland and calcareous fen.

Type of work in which you will be involved

The work is primarily scything and raking, but also includes coppicing, pollarding and building/maintaining dams across the stream.

Experience &/or qualifications needed:

Keen and enthusiastic people! Everyone welcome. No experience is needed, as full training will be provided for all tasks. A reasonable level of fitness is required.

Times/days we would like you to be available

Every Monday, starting at 10:00am. We finish work around 2:30pm, although anyone is welcome to do fewer hours. We also have occasional Saturday tasks throughout the year.
